

Mental Health Intervention Team Program

Mental Health Providers

Each MHIT participating USD or qualified school selects a mental health provider(s) they would like to work with. Mental Health Providers participating in the MHIT program must:

- Provide 24/7 access to crisis coordination and emergency response services;
- Work with the school liaison and clinical therapist to identify students and triage priorities for treatment;
- Provide outreach to students, families and child welfare contacts to help engage in treatment;
- Participate in the treatment planning process;
- Help maintain communication between all entities, including the family, student, school, clinical therapist, child welfare contacts and the community;
- Maintain the treatment plan and necessary treatment protocols required by the mental health intervention team provider;
- Make referrals to appropriate community resources;
- Help reconnect students and families when they are not following through with the treatment process;
- Engage with the student in the classroom, the home or the community to help build skills wherever needed
